### Passport of a citizen of the Republic of Belarus

The form of a biometric passport of a citizen of the Republic of Belarus (hereinafter referred to as a biometric passport) is a material construction, the size of which corresponds to the size of ID-3 type identification cards.

Dimensions of the biometric passport in accordance with the International Civil Aviation Organization recommendations for machine-readable travel documents (ICAO DOC 9303, edition 7, 2015) are:

- width  $88 \pm 0.75$  mm;
- height  $125 \pm 0.75$  mm;
- thickness  $5.8 \pm 0.2$  mm;
- rounding radius of outer corners  $3 \pm 0.20$  mm.

The biometric passport booklet consists of:

- a cover with an integrated chip and a paper flyleaf;
- a booklet of 32 pages;
- a polycarbonate sheet with personal data page.

The biometric passport book is sewn with a closed stitch with a spacing of 6 mm using two single threads of red and green colour.

Serial number of the biometric passport form consisting of two letters "XX" of the Latin alphabet and seven Arabic numerals is laser punched on pages 1 - 32, including the second page of the document flyleaf.

#### Cover

Biometric passport cover is made of heat-resistant material of dark blue colour with gold foil stamping:

- texts "РЭСПУБЛІКА БЕЛАРУСЬ", "РЕСПУБЛИКА БЕЛАРУСЬ", "REPUBLIC OF BELARUS" in three lines;
- an image of the the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Belarus;
- texts "ПАШПАРТ", "ПАСПОРТ", "PASSPORT" in three lines;
- the logo of the e-passport.

### **Flyleaf**

The biometric passport flyleaf is made of a single sheet of white paper without a watermark and is glued to the inside cover.

The pages of the biometric passport flyleaf have a background grid of two colours with an irisic roll-up. The design of the background grid consists of a combination of graphic security elements with an irregular structure.

In the central part of the first page of the flyleaf of the biometric passport there is a colour image of the Coat of Arms of the Republic of Belarus.

On the second page of the biometric passport flyleaf from top to bottom there are":


- texts "РЭСПУБЛІКА БЕЛАРУСЬ", "РЕСПУБЛИКА БЕЛАРУСЬ", "REPUB-LIC OF BELARUS" in three lines;

- a multilayer optical security element, representing a graphic image of the map of the Republic of Belarus with the serial number of the biometric passport form in the centre, consisting of two letters "XX" of the Latin alphabet and seven Arabic numerals;
- the texts "У ПАШПАРЦЕ 32 ПРАНУМАРАВАНЫЯ СТАРОНКІ", "В ПАСПОРТЕ 32 ПРОНУМЕРОВАННЫЕ СТРАНИЦЫ", "THIS PASSPORT CONTAINS 32 NUMBERED PAGES" in three lines.

### The front side of the polycarbonate sheet

The polycarbonate sheet of the biometric passport is sewn into the booklet with a flexible thin polymeric strip (hinge), the spine of which is located between page 32 and the second page of the flyleaf.

The front side of the polycarbonate sheet of the biometric passport has a background grid of two colours with an irisic roll-up. The background grid pattern consists of a combination of graphic security elements with an irregular pattern.

The front side of the polycarbonate sheet of the biometric passport features the texts "ПАШПАРТ ГРАМАДЗЯНІНА РЭСПУБЛІКІ БЕЛАРУСЬ", "ПАСПОРТ ГРАЖДАНИНА РЕСПУБЛИКИ БЕЛАРУСЬ", "PASSPORT OF A CITIZEN OF THE REPUBLIC OF BELARUS" in nine lines.

### Personal data page

The reverse side of the polycarbonate sheet (personal data page) of the biometric passport has a background grid of two colours with an irisic roll-up. The background grid pattern consists of a combination of graphical security elements with an irregular structure. There is no background grid in the areas reserved for photo-image and secondary photo-image.

The personal data page of the biometric passport is designed in accordance with the recommendations of the International Civil Aviation Organization for machine-readable travel documents (Part 4 of ICAO DOC 9303), divided into 17 fields and readable horizontally.

The page for personal data includes:

- in the upper left-hand corner there is the e-passport logo printed by optically variable ink:
- in the upper part there are texts "PASSPORT", "REPUBLIC OF BELARUS";
- in the central part there are texts "Type", "Country code", "Passport number"; Names of the personalization columns: "Surname", "Given names", "Nationality"; "Date of birth", "Sex", "Date of issue", "Date of expiry"; "Identification No.", "Authority code", "Place of birth", "Holder's signature";
- three holographic elements in the form of a bird, a stylized flower and a sphere;
- in the left side there is unprinted with a grid background area for a photo of the holder:

- in the right side there is unprinted area for a secondary photo image of the document holder;
- at the bottom there is machine-readable area with background grid.

The machine-readable data, consisting of two lines, and personalization data is entered by laser engraving and ink-jet printing.

## The inside (typical) pages of passport

The inside (typical) pages 1 to 32 of the biometric passport are made of water-marked document paper containing visible red fibers.

The pages have a background grid of two colours with an irisic roll-up. The background grid pattern consists of a combination of irregularly shaped graphical security elements.

In the right bottom corner of page 2 of the biometric passport booklet there is a vertical line and output data including the year of issue and the name of the manufacturer of the biometric passport.

On pages 2 and 3 of the biometric passport, in the upper part there are texts "ІНШЫЯ АДЗНАКІ/ДРУГИЕ ОТМЕТКИ/ОТНЕЯ NOTES" in two lines.

On pages 4 - 32 in the upper part of the biometric passport there are texts "ВІЗЫ / ВИЗЫ / VISAS".

Page numbers in the biometric passport are placed in the bottom corner at the page cut-off.


